



Endre Rösjö's NHH/HBS stipend

The purpose of the stipend is to give talented and ambitious students from NHH an opportunity to attend the MBA program at Harvard Business School (HBS). The stipend will cover tuition as well as costs of living and travel, currently estimated at around \$170,000 for the two years. Admission into the MBA program requires work experience, and NHH alums are therefore encouraged to apply a few years after graduation.

Eligibility

Award of the stipend requires the candidate to:

- Be a Norwegian national or an American national of Norwegian descent (at least one of the great-grand parents or grandparents must be Norwegian).
- Have a bachelor's degree from NHH.
- Been admitted to or intend to apply for admissions to HBS.

The payout of the scholarship is conditional on acceptance into HBS. After graduating from HBS, the receiver of the scholarship will give a lecture at NHH.

Application procedures

Application deadline is March 1. Submit the application with the required documentation to post@centennial.no. Applicants will receive notice of the decision by June 1. Under special circumstances, applications may be considered at other times.

Criteria for evaluation of candidates

Applicants will be evaluated on a range of criteria, which all are important for admissions to HBS. These criteria include, but are not limited to:

- Grade point average in NHH's bachelors program.
- GMAT score.
- The purpose of the MBA, as stated in an essay describing how the education at HBS could help the candidate achieve his or her career goals.
- Relevant work experience.
- Other extracurricular activities providing evidence of the candidate's social engagement, work capacity, and ability to undertake projects.

The stipend committee will make an overall assessment of the applicants, ranking candidates who (i) either have been admitted, or (ii) are perceived to have a high likelihood of being admitted to HBS.
